

Inflation dashboard

February 2025



The Federated Hermes Inflation Dashboard is a snapshot of US inflation. The dashboard's indicators work together to create a more comprehensive picture of inflation's trajectory on a monthly basis rather than relying just on the Federal Reserve's preferred inflation metric, Core Personal Consumption Expenditures.

Will inflation settle to be consistent with long-term averages, or the low-inflation environment seen from 2000-2019?
